1. Welcome and Apologies

6. Parish Council Update

Paul S gave a summary of relevant items from the most recent Parish Council (PC) meeting.

- The Bridge opening has been put back to 19 Feb.
- The Speedwatch scheme is no longer going ahead due to lack of suitable locations to set up the cameras. The PC are exploring other traffic calming methods.
- Keith Tillet has repaired any damaged benches in the Parish.
- The PC would like to put forward some articles for the Stutton Standard including wildflowers on Garnet Lane and what to do with the newly adopted telephone box.
- PC have agreed to fund a beacon and are currently looking at suitable sites. If in place in time we could use for the Armistice day service.
