Halloween, same format as last year, need a sub committee at the next meeting.

Bonfire Night, Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> November same format as last year all timing etc.

Need donations for fireworks, need to secure a large marquee and the one from last year is not available.

Bulb Planting/Litter Picking, Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> October from 10am although this was put down as bulb planting it was decided to do it as a village tidy up, litter pick etc,

Book the VH offer refreshments, posters need to be up and advertised on FB nearer the time.

Christmas Market – Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> November from 10am, this needs to be a sub-committee, confirm who at the next meeting.

Christmas Event, Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> December, again same as last year, ET said her new band will play, MH said the choir would she would ask, no stalls, just refreshments and mince pies and craft table for the children. Christmas tree has been donated.  
Also need Father Christmas, confirm sub-committee.
