1. Welcome and Apologies

Emily welcomed everyone to the meeting and gave the apologies.

2. Action from the previous meeting

All actions from the last been meeting have been done, except for Nigel who still has to get litter pick sticks when available.

3. Previous Events

Race Night – Mike gave a review of the evening which was a complete success and the currency of Stutton the Groat work very well adding a different dimension to the evening.

Sophie will issue a final total for the night but below are the approx. amount raised.

£150 approx. profit from the evening, with $\frac{3}{4}$ of a barrel of beer left over which was carried forward to the following PUP making the total approx £200.

4. Future Events

Summer Fete – Emily took the lead on this part of the meeting and ran through all the actions:

Fete programmes – Mike confirmed these have been printed and ready to be distributed to every house in the village including the cottages.

These need sticker on them to identify they are for villagers with a free raffle ticket, one per household, raffle tickets have also been printed.

The stickers will be put on at the PUP on Friday 16th and delivered over the weekend, Sophie, Emily and Nadine and Chris volunteered for this.

Medals for the children's races - Lynsay has purchased them.

Straw Bales – Chris Cully confirmed he has order 20 small bales which will be delivered on Friday 23rd and will need £71 cash on delivery.

Stall Holders – Emily has confirmed all stall holders except for Clay Fever which she will call on Friday 16th.

Portaloos – Emily confirmed the order and will forward the invoice to Sophie to pay.

Table Games – Julie Cully confirmed she has everything under control except perhaps short on prizes and bottles for the bottle for the bag tombola.

CM will ask for donation on FB.

CC will make a board for the bag tombola.

Mike suggested we give out the Stutton Groat as prizes, each groat is worth £1 which can be exchanged at any stall, and the external stall holders will be reimbursed with cash to the value of each groat taken; all agreed it was a good idea.

Footballs – Emily will get these pumped up.

Sweets – Nadine will make the bags up for the sweet stall.

Cake Stall – Lynsay said lots of promises of cakes, has tea, coffee, sugar, plates, cups etc. Milk is needed.

Bar – The bar is stocked and Paul C has the licence, Julie & Paul C to run.

BBQ – Emily confirmed the order for the BBQ as follows:

70 sausages, 130 burgers and 200 bread buns and sauces and agreed to cancel the pork pies and up the burgers and bread order, just need cheese, blue gloves and anti bacterial wipes, Paul & Nigel.

Bouncy Castle – Emily and Mags will be doing this, confirmed 2 queue under 5's and over 5's and will have 5 mins on a turn, Julie C said to get baby wipes on hand for any spillages/face paint on the BC.
