Parish Council Elections 2019

Parish councils are elected for four year terms, with the current term ending in Spring this year. At that point our five elected representatives must all stand down and, if they wish, offer themselves for re-election.



At the moment the five parish councillors happen all to be male and from Stutton village or the nearby Wingate Hill. However our parish is “Stutton cum Hazlewood” and, as the map shows, takes in both settlements and the surrounding countryside plus the southern part of the Woodlands Estate;

the majority of properties to the south of Woodlands Avenue are in Stutton cum Hazlewood Parish rather than Tadcaster.

We would encourage the widest possible representation on our Parish Council and hope that there will be interest from all parts of the parish.
